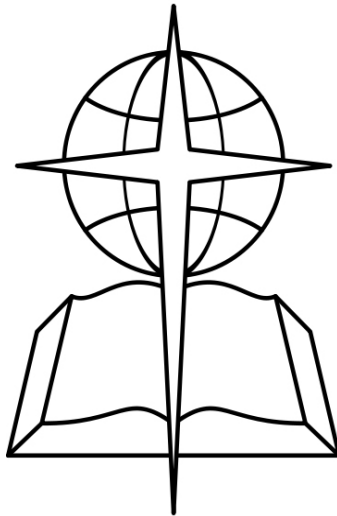

2022 Association Missionary Report

2022 has been a great year for Tattnell-Evans Baptist (TEBA). Since the last annual meeting, we have opened a new ministry center at 214 N Ralph St. in Claxton. If you have not stopped in to visit, please do so. We will be honored to give you a tour. Our insurance company recently valued the new building at \$465,000. We have just over \$225,000 cash in the facility, with another \$125,000 of donated plumbing, HVAC, flooring, equipment, and electrical. The Lord has blessed TEBA!

Opening the new building has brought Good Health Ministries into existence. Good Health opened on 2-22-22 (Feb 22, 2022). The clinic has right at 90 patients and growing steadily. Wendy West is the clinic director and is doing a fantastic job. TEBA is blessed to have a great group of volunteers serving the patients. These volunteers represent seven of our churches. There is a continued need for folks wishing to serve—contact Wendy or me for more information. Also, watch for training opportunities throughout the year. There is mandatory training for everyone working in the clinic. Dr. Paul Thompson is our Medical Director who committed his Doctors, Nurse Practitioners, and Physician Assistant helping at the clinic. In addition, two other Nurse Practitioners are working at the clinic for a total of seven practitioners.

In the past month, Heartbeat Crisis Pregnancy Center has opened. Heartbeat will provide pregnancy tests, Sonograms, support, and education and is open to anyone. There are no financial restrictions for services. In addition, we have pregnancy and parenting educational opportunities where those expecting and with children up to two years of age can earn ‘baby bucks’ and purchase items from the Boutique. Two of our churches provided the funds, \$25,000, to purchase a sonogram and another \$9,000 to stock the boutique.

If you want to give financially to Good Health Ministries or Heartbeat Crisis Pregnancy, you may do so on our website tebaonline.org. Look for the PayPal button. The button will allow you to designate either ministry. You may also make a one-time gift or make it monthly.

The Annual Backpacks for Appalachia was held on Saturday, Dec 18, in Ducktown, TN., at the Copper Basin Crisis Center. A large group representing several TEBA Churches participated. The group gave out several hundred backpacks, a Christmas meal, including a ham, and provided a meal and activities for all who came. This annual event will be held on Saturday, Dec 10, 2022. If you would like to participate, please get in touch with me soon so hotel reservations can be made in the next couple of weeks.

In early November, Brother David Lamm and I participated in a vision trip to Puerto Rico. The trip was to expose Pastors and Association Leaders to the opportunities in the US Territory.

In March, TEBA was set up to participate in the annual Wildlife Festival with a Baby Comfort Station, but a windstorm on Friday evening destroyed the tents forcing the activity to be canceled. We are planning to provide the Comfort Station in March at the Festival.

In July, a team of five was scheduled to travel to Haiti for VBS and a Medical Clinic, but Lynn and I did not receive our passport renewal on time, so we had to reschedule. The trip was scheduled for last week and was canceled due to the government closing all roads in Haiti and the lack of fuel. The team traveled to Fajardo, Puerto Rico, and worked with Pastor Albert and his church plant. In May, there is a trip planned for Southeast Asia. If you have an interest, please get in touch with me for more information.

The WMU hosted the Inspirational Banquet at Evergreen in February. In addition, the annual Sugar Time was at Cobbtown in May. Both events are scheduled for the coming year.

The Men's Ministry continues to provide wheelchair ramps in Tattnall and Evans Counties. There is a project planned for Saturday, Oct 29, on the Daisy-Nevil's Highway just North of Faith Baptist. Work will begin at 8:00. Also, the Men's Ministry will be hosting a Children's Fishing Day in the Spring and a fish fry for men and boys around the same time.

The Annual Choir-fest was held Sunday night at Elza. Please begin to make plans for 2023. We will strive to get information about the event out earlier next year.

You will see in the Book of Reports the annual budget. There is a substantial increase due to the addition of Good Health and Heartbeat expenses. Together, and by the Lord's provisions, we can accomplish much.

I want to encourage us to remember this is our Association. Working together, we are a powerful force for the Good News of Jesus.

***Minutes of TEBA Executive Committee Meeting
Thursday, February 24, 2022
Eastside Baptist Church***

The Executive Committee Meeting was called to order by Dr. David Daus.

Dr. Matt Brady welcomed the Executive Committee and spoke of the conflict in Ukraine. Bro. Matt said that the world needs our prayers now for Ukraine and the people there. We were reminded that the Lord is their refuge. Please pray for Ukraine! We were also briefly introduced to the Voices of Truth, a group of eight students from Brewton Parker College who were there to bring our praise in song.

Dr. Daus called attention to the minutes of the last quarterly meeting on October 21, 2021. He asked everyone to review the minutes on page 28 of the Minutes Book. Dr. Daus stated that the financial report would be available in the Tattnall/Evans March newsletter which would be emailed within the next week and encouraged everyone to review the financial report when published.

Standing Committee Reports:

Due to an abbreviated meeting to enjoy the concert by Voices of Truth, there were no Standing Committee Reports at tonight's meeting.

New Business: None

SPECIAL REPORTS:

Georgia Baptist Executive Committee: Rev. David Lamm stated that at the Executive Committee held on March 15, 2021, there were questions about the Cooperative Program and church contributions. Bro. David stated that a committee has been appointed by Georgia Baptist Convention to investigate the money going to cooperative programs and whether to withdraw from the program. Bro. David asked that TEBA churches allow the Convention proper time to review the Cooperative Program before withdrawing contributions. Rogers Baptist members investigated the Cooperative Program by contacting a member of the Cooperative Program at Ga. Baptist Mission Board and learned that contributions can be directed to specific programs within the program. Bro. David encouraged other churches to also contact a Cooperative Program representative to learn more about directing contributions.

Hispanic Church Ministries: Dr. Daus reported that Rev. Roman Rodriguez is very ill and is currently taking dialysis treatments. Please pray for Bro. Roman.

Good Health Ministries: Wendy West gave an update on the status of Good Health Ministries. The clinic is now open and serving patients! Kelly Daus, Heather Lewis are working at the clinic which is open on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Now that the clinic is operational, patients are needed for medical

and dental needs. Wendy brought packets of information for everyone to pick up and distribute as needed. Each packet contains a brochure on Good Health Ministries, an application form, flyer, and volunteer interest forms. Wendy stated that they will also mail application packets to each church.

Wendy reviewed the qualifications for patients: persons that have no insurance and meet 200% of the poverty level financially. Patient records will be reviewed for primary care services, counselors will be on hand for every patient, and dental care will be provided as needs are determined. Wendy stated that if there are any questions from potential patients or TEBA church members that phone numbers are on the packet and brochure for assistance.

ASSOCIATIONAL MISSIONARY REPORT

Good Health Ministries: Associational Missionary Rev. Freddy Gardner started his report with reiterating the information that Wendy provided: The clinic is open with practitioners ready to serve patients, and that the clinic needs patients! TEBA members were encouraged to take application packets out to the public and to share information. There will be a Grand Opening and ribbon cutting at the clinic on March 14 at 1:30 p.m. Larry Wynn and Rex Mobley of the Georgia Baptist Healthcare Foundation will be on hand at the Grand Opening.

Bro. Freddy then introduced Dr. David Wilson from the Music Department at Brewton Parker College.
