Thursday, August 17, 2023  
Unity in Christ Baptist Church***

***SPECIAL REPORTS:***

**Georgia Baptist Executive Committee:** Rev. David Lamm stated that the next meeting of the Executive Committee will be in September. He will provide and update at the TEBA annual meeting in October.

**Hispanic Church Ministries:** Rev. Freddy Gardner requested that everyone please continue to keep Rev. Roman Rodriguez in your prayers as his health is still not good. Praise report - the doctors have determined the cause of his medical issues and are treating him accordingly; he is making improvements and is back in the pulpit.

**Good Health Ministries:** Mrs. Wendy West gave an update on Good Health Ministries. The clinic is doing great with 132 active patients. 15 individuals have been helped in getting insurance and/or a job with insurance. Heartbeat is currently actively serving 9 families with education programs and general support. Both Good Health and Heartbeat have active social media pages on Facebook. Wendy encouraged everyone to like the two pages and look for updates on work being done to help our patients.

**ASSOCIATIONAL MISSIONARY REPORT** Rev. Freddy Gardner reported on upcoming ministry opportunities.

**Men's ministry** has 3 wheel chair ramps that are being planned and help will be needed by any and all interested in participating. These projects are now being funded by and outside organization, we just supply the workers to complete the projects.

(August 17, 2023- Executive Committee Meeting Minutes Con't)

Mission Team is in the process of planning a trip to Puerto Rico next summer – looking for a team of approximately 15 – 18 people. Will be a reasonable cost of less than \$1000 per individual for anyone interested in helping a sister church. Christmas Backpacks for Ducktown – our goal is 600 backpacks. The event will take place on December 8 – 9. Rev. Gardner reminded everyone that there is a great need for the backpacks as this is the only Christmas that some of the children will receive. Backpacks can be turned into the TEBA office or to First Baptist Collins by no later than November 27.

New Prison Ministry project – Christmas Cards for Prisoners in the TEBA area prisons. Ask that churches in the association make Christmas Cards with no personal identifying information and bring to TEBA for us to pass along to the prisons. More details to come in letter to be sent out to all churches within the next couple of weeks.

Good Health, Heartbeat and TEBA have recently been impacted by the need for translators as well as Haitian Creole speaking pastors in our area as we are seeing an increase in the Haitian population in our communities.

New Pastors in Association TEBA has 3 new pastors in the association – Brandon Newell – 1<sup>st</sup> Baptist Glennville; David Daus – 1<sup>st</sup> Baptist Claxton; John Roberts – Youth Pastor 1<sup>st</sup> Baptist Glennville.

Music Ministry Annual Choirfest to take place on October 15 @ Elza Baptist. Sheet music and music for mass choir special will be available soon.

**Devotional:** Rev. Murray Benefield provided an inspiring devotional on finding peace and good cheer even in the midst of the discouraging times we are living through. In John 16:33, Jesus knowing his own destiny, provided words of encouragement that we might have peace and be of good cheer. Nothing caught Jesus by surprise, He encouraged us even knowing what was to come in the future. We can look to John 3:16 to be reminded of God's LOVE, GRACE, MERCY, and COMPASSION. We must remember GOD loves ME! We can experience peace because we know GOD LOVES ME! Lamentations 3:22 – 23 reminds us God's mercy and compassion are new all the time, they are there all the time. GOD is in control. Jesus overcame the world, we can overcome the world as well.

**Wrap-Up:** Rev. Moore called everyone's attention to the upcoming calendar of events on the agenda. Prayer slips were passed around for everyone to pray for churches in the TEBA.

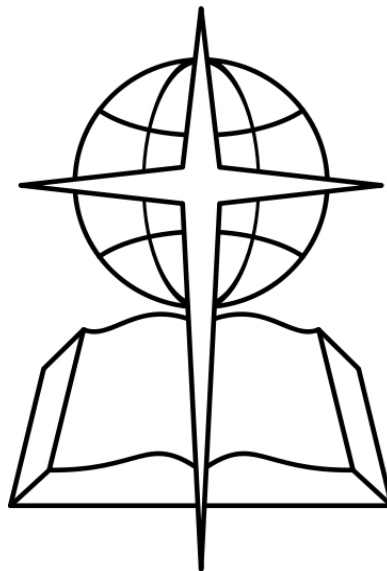

## 2023 Association Missionary Report

I am regularly amazed by the Lord's blessings for your Tattnell-Evans Baptist Association (TEBA). 2023 has been a year in which the Lord continues to bless this Association with steady growth of ministry and ministry opportunities.

Heartbeat Pregnancy Center has completed a year of operation. The Center saw several women undergo biblically based training, earning "Baby Bucks," which they exchange for items in the Boutique. The Boutique has ongoing needs, so please read Wendy's monthly report in the Association Connections. On Feb. 29, 2024, Heartbeat will host a fundraising banquet.

Good Health Ministries continues to grow. This ministry is blessed to have faithful volunteers who are the 'backbone' of our success. We are always in need of volunteers. We can use you if you have 4 hours a month. If you have an interest, please reach out to Wendy or me. Good Health has added Kathy Hill to the staff as the Records clerk this year. Please pray for this ministry.

In early December, a large group from TEBA held a Christmas Party at Copper Basin Crisis Center in Ducktown, TN. The group distributed over 500 backpacks, 125 hams, provided lunch, and enjoyed ministering and talking with people. This annual event will be on Saturday, Dec. 9.

In February, Steve and Wendy West and Lynn and I completed a mission trip to Haiti. We had the opportunity to fly on a 1948 model DC3 airplane. On this trip to Maissade, we had the opportunity to set up a permanent Medical Clinic.

Six people traveled to Dhaka, Bangladesh on a vision trip with the IMB in May. The group had the opportunity to meet with IMB staff and visited several ministry sites. One of the trip's highlights was sharing directly with people in the local parks. Dhaka, by 2030, will be the largest city in the world and has less than one percent Christian witness.

Through your generosity, Lynn and I recently traveled with Dr. Matt Brady and a group from the community to Israel. Walking in the land that our Bible stories come from made the Bible come to life. Highlights of the trip included the Garden Tomb, Golgotha, Qumran, the Garden of Gethsemane, the Sea of Galilee, Magodo, The Old City, and the Dead Sea, just to name a few places we visited. This week (Oct. 8), the news reported that Hamas attacked Israel. The Nation of Israel is at war. Please pray for Israel.

TEBA Men's Ministry completed some wheelchair ramps this past year. The ministry will be working on two projects shortly—one on Saturday, Oct. 21, at Highways 129 and 169 (white house) intersection. The second will be on Saturday, Nov. 4, at 407 W. Liberty St in Claxton. There is another ramp in the process and three additional ones that need to be scheduled.

Our Mission Team continues to meet, keeping us focused on missions. The team hosts the baby comfort station each year at the Wildlife Festival. Promotes and directs the Backpacks for Appalachia and helps in directing the mission effort of the Association. The team is also leading us to provide handwritten Christmas Cards to all prisoners in the two counties. For more information on this, please reach out to me. The Association will sponsor a trip to Fajardo, Puerto Rico, in early July 2024. Dates have not been finalized but should be set in the next few weeks. The trip will support a new church plant doing children's ministry events.

**(2023 Association Missionary Report Con't)**

You will see in our budget a request from the Evangelism Team to create an Evangelistic Block Party Trailer. This is a brand-new project, and more information will come in the next month.

The WMU held the annual Inspiration Banquet at Pine Grove and Sugar-time at First Baptist, Glennville.

As we close out another wonderful Associational Year, let me remind you that TEBA is your Association. People often ask what the Association does for our church – we are here to serve as best we can – but that is the wrong question. The correct question is, what can we do as a networked group of Churches to reach Tattnall and Evans Counties, Georgia, the United States, and the World with the Gospel of Jesus Christ?

## 2023 Good Health Ministries Report

Good Health Ministries continues to offer help and hope to our communities. Reporting period is from 10/1/2022 – 9/30/2023. We have 101 active patients; 17 patients have been discharged related to obtaining an insurance plan or relocating and 39 have been discharged related to noncompliance with the program. We continue to partner with churches of Tattnell-Evans Baptist Association, Evans Memorial Hospital, MAP International, GA Baptist Healthcare Ministry Foundation, Strickland Foundation, Rotary. We measure our effectiveness based on the decreased number of Emergency Department visits by patients – 22 total with 18 unrelated diagnoses to hypertension, high cholesterol, asthma, diabetes; 2 cases were related to diabetes, 1 related to hypertension, 1 related to clinic was closed. We also monitor lab values to include hemoglobin A1C, cholesterol levels and blood pressure readings. We report quarterly to MAP International.

GHM monitors volunteer hours and reports quarterly to the Department of Public Health. Total number of Patients Visits as of September 30, 2023, is 261 and that is 261 times we have shared the gospel message and provided spiritual guidance. We have 10 (gaining 1) Licensed Volunteer Health Care Providers volunteering a total of 279.5 hours. We have 16 (gaining 3) administrative volunteers serving a total of 681.5 (decreased 19.5) hours. GHM has hired 1 part-time administrative role.

GHM offers education opportunities and outreach within the community. Online education consisted of teaching on “Depression” and “Mental Health as a Mission Field”. Outreach consisted of social media platform on Facebook; Rotary Governor Tour of the center; speaking at the Inspirational Banquet, Oak Grove Baptist, Aline Bible Study, First Church, Glennville First Baptist; table set up at Baby Comfort Station, Easter in the Park in Cobbtown, Fun Day in Collins, Glennville Onion Festival, Evans Co Back to School Bash.

GHM volunteers participated in a field trip to MAP International on July 11. 13 volunteers helped put together hurricane crisis care packages. A “Thank You” meal was prepared and served for our volunteers on April 4<sup>th</sup> in honor of GHM 1 year celebration.

Heartbeat continues to provide support for families in our area to live abundantly. We are equipped to help those ladies in a crisis and/or provide education to their entire support system, including fathers. Heartbeat offers parenting classes, verification of pregnancy, support with Medicaid application process, fatherhood classes, adoption options, OB/GYN referral assistance, life skills classes.

Clients are eligible to obtain baby bucks and can cash out for items such as diapers, bottles, diaper bags, onesies, pack-n-play, crib with mattress, etc. We have served 19 clients and currently have 8 active clients. If you know anyone or a family that would be interested in the education program, please reach out to us.

We continue to partner with Abiding Love Adoption Agency and our local OB-GYN offices.
