“The Joyful Noise”

In the summer of 1997 my wife Carole and I had been married ten years; our daughter Lydia had just turned one year old, and our son Jaren was only five. I was at the church office serving at Corinth Baptist Church in Jonesboro, GA at my first full-time Minister of Music position, when I received a phone call that my wife had been taken by ambulance to what was then Georgia Baptist Hospital. Carole had passed out in our McDonough home and our little five-year-old boy was savvy enough to go over to our neighbor's house and tell her his Mommy had “gone night-night”. Our wonderful neighbor called 911, took care of our son and baby daughter, and the ambulance took Carole to the Georgia Baptist ER.

Carole suffered a severe subarachnoid hemorrhage, or brain bleed, coded twice in the ambulance, and was revived by the paramedics before arriving at the hospital. By the time I arrived at Georgia Baptist, Carole was hooked intubated and hooked up to all kinds of tubes. The doctors told me that if she regained consciousness, she probably would never be the same. Two days later Carole woke up in the ICU with an intensely painful headache and numbness throughout her entire body. Slowly the headache pain subsided enough where she could function somewhat, and two weeks later she was allowed to go home. For the next nine months our Corinth church family provided meals, home care, and child care for us.

Other than having to learn to speak, use her arms and hands, and walk again, Carole lost all memories of her previous life. She didn't remember her childhood, our wedding, or the birth of her two children. During those nine months of recovery she first used a wheelchair, then a walker, then a cane, and finally full mobility. I shared pictures of our wedding, babies, family and she slowly regained a lot of her physical and mental strength back, but the memories were mostly gone. We had hundreds of people praying for Carole during that time, and God answered our prayers. She returned to teaching Special Education a year later, home schooled both our children, and now has an enormous capacity to memorize and quote entire passages of scripture.

Just this past Sunday morning in worship, Carole quoted Revelation 22 verse by verse prior to us singing a duet of **“The Last Page of the Bible”** by Matthew West and Anne Wilson. Never doubt the unlimited power and authority our Lord Jesus has over illness, pain, and suffering. We have experienced His healing firsthand as a married couple and as a family. As this song says, “Troubles may last for a moment, the weeping may last for a night. But I've read the last page of the Bible, and it's all gonna be alright!” Carole is the most Christ-like woman I have ever known, and God continues to use her daily as an encouragement to others.

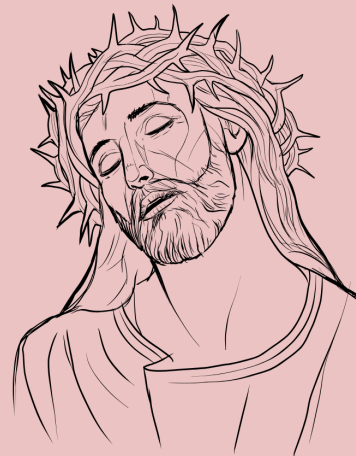

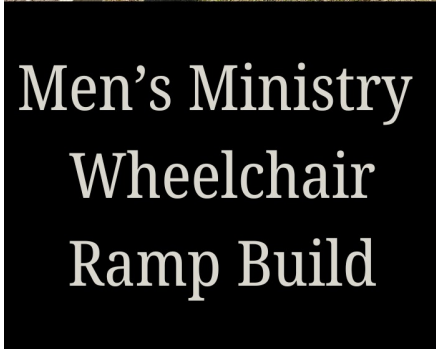
