Song Spotlight- Trust in God

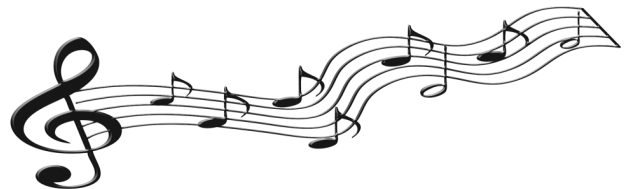
One of my favorite Bible stories is Daniel and the lion’s den. Daniel 6: 19-23 says, “At the first light of dawn, King Darius got up and hurried to the lions’ den. When he came near the den, he called to Daniel in an anguished voice, ‘Daniel, servant of the living God, has your God, whom you serve continually, been able to rescue you from the lions?’ Daniel answered, ‘May the king live forever! My God sent his angel, and he shut the mouths of the lions. They have not hurt me, because I was found innocent in God’s sight. Nor have I ever done any wrong before you, your Majesty.’ King Darius was overjoyed and gave orders to lift Daniel out of the den. And when Daniel was lifted from the den, no wound was found on him, because he had trusted in his God.”

There is a famous painting by the Flemish painter Rubens that hangs in the National Gallery of Art in Washington, DC. The painting shows Daniel in the middle of several hungry lions, with the bones of what they had eaten at Daniel’s feet. Daniel is not staring at the lions in fright, but looking firmly up to heaven, with the Light of God shining on Daniel. That should be the way every one of us should be living every day during these crisis times, keeping our eyes fixed on our Lord Jesus, our Protector, our God of angel armies.

My must obey and trust God in everything that we do, no matter how difficult the times may be, and leave the consequences to Him. The song I recommend this month is “**Trust in God**” by Elevation Worship. Only three days from our scheduled departure, our group of 232 Jubal Ministries musicians still did not have travel visas from the Cuban government. We continued to pray, trust, and believe our God was a big enough God to give us those visas before October 16, our flight day to Cuba. The morning of October 13 we received those government visas, and nine days of marvelous ministry took place throughout the cities of Havana and Santa Clara, Cuba October 16 to 24. We can know our God will always come through for His servants, and we can trust God and in His timing.

May I end with a quote from Charles Stanley that has meant the world to me, “If you are a child of God, the only things that can happen to you, are the things that God **allows** to happen. If you are a child of God, what He allows, he allows for a reason.” Be encouraged today my dear brothers and sisters, keep your eyes on the Light that is God. He loves you, He is in control, and you can trust Him.
